Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting on 13th June 2022

There were no public questions

- 22/FC6A To receive any apologies of non-attendance.
Councillors M Simpson, K Croker, J Ronicle and J Maycocke sent their apologies.
- 22/FC6B To receive any declarations of interest on agenda items.
There were no declarations of interest on the agenda
- 22/FC6C To confirm and sign the minutes of the Parish Council meeting held on 4th May 2022
It was resolved to approve the minutes of the Parish Council held on 4th May 2022.
- 22/FC6D North Somerset Matters.
Councillor Keating reported that he would ask the teams from various departments to liaise regarding plans for footpaths and highways regarding suggestions on the Banwell Bypass. Plans for improvements to the bus services in the county will be implemented as £58M has been granted to North Somerset Council. The scheme is divided into two sections-part one will address infrastructure to run more smoothly and the second will look at new and restored services. This will address the next 3 years of funding and discussions of how to sustain the scheme will be required. There will be a detailed proposal at the end of June.
Councillor Keating advised that the application for 25 houses on Dinghurst Road had been approved. Councillor Murray raised concerns regarding the inquiry and protocols followed with information that was not accurate. Councillor Keating will advise on the process to follow for the Parish Council to raise a complain. The Council will draft a letter and Councillor Keating will co-sign. Councillor Keating will send an update on the Housing Land Supply. Councillor Keating will follow up the meeting with the CEO to discuss planning and Crest Nicholson regarding the parcel of land given to the Parish. A meeting with Councillor Steve Hogg is planned to discuss roads in the villages which the Council will be invited to attend.

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- 22/FC6E To discuss the Banwell Bypass Consultation.
It was agreed that the Council would ask Winscombe and Sandford Parish Council if they would like to do a joint response to North Somerset Council regarding the changes made from the consultation.
- 22/FC6F To consider the request to add cycle path markings on A368 for children cycling to school.
It was agreed that the Parish Council would add this request to the Banwell Bypass Team for consideration. The Clerk will contact David Bailey at NSC Highways to ask for recommendations to help with the issue. The Clerk will also ask Churchill Academy if they can ask the Police to recap of cycling proficiency.
- 22/FC6G To consider the request from Churchill Minibus Society to make changes to their constitution by removing a clause for the Committee to consist of 2 nominations from each Church and one from the Parish Council, and 5 elected members at the annual general meeting. To replace the clause with the following: That each of the Churches and the Parish Councils may nominate any person(s) to act as its representative on the Management committee or at any general meeting of the Society.
It was resolved that Councillors J Murry and B Wilkinson would be the Councils representatives on the Management Committee or at any general meeting of the Society.
- 22/FC6H To consider the protocol for Operation London Bridge.
It was agreed that when the Monarch passes, there would be a book of condolence at the Community Café and a tree to be planted in memorial at the recreation field. Should members of the public wish to lay flowers they can do so at the clock enclosure. The clerk will ask what preference has been set and confirm protocol.
