21-22/LC10A To receive any apologies of non-attendance.  
There were no apologies of absence.

21-22/LC10B To receive any declarations of interest on agenda items.  
There were no declarations of interest

21-22/LC10C To confirm and sign the minutes of the meeting held on 28<sup>th</sup> June 2021.  
It was resolved to approve the minutes of the meeting held on 28<sup>th</sup> June 2021.

21-22/LC10D To elect a chairman.  
It was agreed that J Bush would act as chairman until May 2022.

21-22/LC10E To discuss the request to store a container under the trees by the compost area.  
It was agreed that the Cricket Club would research a suitable container.

21-22/LC10F To receive an update from the Cricket Club and the lease request.  
It was agreed that the Parish Council would agree to a lease request with the Cricket Club and equally share the cost to prepare the lease. Details of the agreement must be agreed by both parties before a legal agreement is prepared.  
The Cricket Club will obtain an independent quote to prepare a lease.

It was agreed to ask the previous contractor to quote for the repairs for the next meeting.

21-22/LC08H To consider a replacement gate for the play area  
It was agreed in principle to install a one-way gate. The clerk will clarify if the supplier will install the gate as well as delivery as per their quote and where they are delivering from.

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- 21-22/LC08I To consider the goal posts quotations  
It was agreed that mobile goal posts are required, and the clerk will obtain quotes.
- 21-22/LC08J To receive an update from the Ladies Rugby Training Group.  
There was no update from the Ladies Rugby Training Group.
- 21-22/FC08K To receive matters for information and future agenda items  
The Cricket Club Lease.  
The patio at the cricket club needs re-pointing.  
There is a leak in the central part of the roof of the Cricket Club, the clerk will action a contractor to repair this. The grass needs to be cut twice weekly from April, and the grass needs to be cut up to the hedges. The outdoor gym equipment and flood lights need maintenance.  
The Council will consider a site for a tree to be planted for the Queens Green Canopy and Jubilee celebrations and additional trees in the Parish through Woodland Trust and the Celebrating 50 years of the Mendip Society.
