Winscombe and Churchill Football Club reported that a 5-year service level agreement had been confirmed with the Parish Council for use of the pitches and changing rooms. The club is now a charity. There are currently 500 players and 30% of them are local to Churchill.
Churchill Cricket Club reported that the floor at the cricket pavilion has transformed the clubhouse. The internal walls are up, the bar is built, and the changing rooms are ready. Carpet is being laid in the main area with artificial grass in the changing rooms. A grand opening is planned before the start of the season.
Quotes have been received for removing the mound of soil in the corner of the of the field. The clerk will also obtain a quote to compare costs. The temporary toilets will be ready for the first match in May.
